1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of orders dated 21.11.2002, 13.02.2003, 21.10.2005 and 09.12.2005 whereby he was awarded punishment of stoppage of three increments and order dated 19.09.2005 whereby he was ordered to retire at the age of 55 years.

2. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner was initially reverted from the rank of Sub Inspector (SI) to Assistant Sub Inspector (ASI), however, said order was withdrawn. The petitioner was subjected to forfeiture of three increments. He was made to retire at the age of 55 years. A period of more than 20 years has passed away. He was issued show cause notice alleging acceptance of bribe while investigating a matter. He was subjected to multiple punishments while in service.

3. It appears that with the efflux of time, petitioner has lost his interest to pursue the instant petition.

4. ***Dismissed*** with liberty to the petitioner to move an

appropriate application within six months from today, if cause survives.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
