NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The Registry has put up the matter in IOIN category to consider the request of the Mediator for extension of time. However, on joint request made by learned counsel for the parties, the main case is taken up on board today itself.

2. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the show cause notice dated 02.07.2009 (Annexure P-5). Further, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to continue to pay regular pension to the petitioner and to release balance gratuity amount to the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh. Amit Arora, General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Ferozepur, submits that all the retiral dues of the petitioner have been released after deducting a sum of Rs.1,00,000/-.



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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite her best efforts, she has not been able to get any instructions from the petitioner.

5. In this view of the matter, the IOIN and the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause of action still survives.
