1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the revised family pension to the petitioner from 01.01.2006/25.04.2013 @ Rs.7675/- and from 01.01.2016 @ Rs.18800/- alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition some amount of the revised family pension has been released to the petitioner, however, entire amount of revised family pension has not been released. He submits on instructions from the petitioner that he may be permitted to file a representation in regard to grant of entire amount of revised family pension and the same be decided by respondent No.2, in a time bound manner.

3. The learned State counsel does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner submits a representation in regard to grant of entire amount of revised family pension, the same be decided within a period of 03 months from the date of its submission in accordance with law.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
