The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the retiral/terminal benefits of the petitioner including gratuity, leave encashment, salary and change of her Permanent Retirement Account Number from 'Government' to 'Private'.
2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner, wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.
