1. Present petition has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct a fair and time-bound enquiry on the representation (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioners and register an FIR against respondents No.4 to 7 for committing acts of criminal intimidation, coercion and undue influence including threatening to commit suicide by climbing a water tank and forcibly obtaining signatures of the petitioners on blank papers.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievances, petitioners have filed a representation dated 02.04.2026 (Annexure P-4) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioners would be satisfied if representation dated 02.04.2026 (Annexure P-4) is decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3-State only.



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4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Raj Karan Singh, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. Heard.

6. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is directed to decide the representation dated 02.04.2026 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

7. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
