1. On 26.07.2023, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court was pleased
to pass the following order:-

for the petitioner.*

Mr. Harsh Vardhan Shehrawat, AAG, Haryana.

*In terms of the speaking order dated 30.05.2023, it
is observed that if the petitioner is given the benefit of 3rd
ACP, which came in existence on 01.01.2006 as per the
Haryana Civil Services (Assured Career Progression) Rules,
2008, then in that eventuality, the petitioner will be entitled to
lesser pay-scale than the pay-scale he is drawing till the date of
his retirement.*



Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already given an undertaking that he is ready to accept the lesser pay but insisted that he should be granted the benefit of 1st ACP.

Let a specific affidavit, in this regard, be filed on the next date of hearing.

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present petition be disposed of but liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the same after complying with the order dated 26.07.2023.
