H.S. GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita seeking bail to the petitioner in NCB Crime No.46 dated 01.07.2021 under Sections 8, 20, 25, 29 and 60 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at NCB Chandigarh.
2. The case of the prosecution is that petitioner along with the co-accused was found in possession of 3 Kg 650 gms of charas and the petitioner is in custody since 01.07.2021.
3. Learned counsel for the NCB submits that the trial of the case is at the fag end. The entire evidence is over and now the case is fixed for defence evidence.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition.
5. Allowed to do so.

6. The present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. However, keeping in view the fact that petitioner is in custody since more than 4 years and 8 months, the learned trial Court is directed to decide and conclude the trial within a period of six months.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
