KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that unfortunately, the petitioner has since died, during the pendency of the instant writ petition. Further, despite making best efforts, his legal representatives are not coming forward to continue with the *lis*.
2. In view of the above, this Court is left with no other option, but to dismiss the petition for want of prosecution.
3. **Dismissed for want of prosecution.** However, in case any cause of action still survives, the legal representatives of the deceased-petitioner are at liberty to move an apt application/motion for revival of the writ petition.
