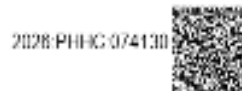


**134 IN THE HIGH COURT OF PUNJAB AND HARYANA

1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS/482 Cr.P.C for quashing the impugned orders dated 09.02.2026 (Annexure P-4) and dated 09.03.2026 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Id. trial court vide which the bail order of the petitioner has been cancelled and bail/surety bonds have been forfeited to the State and Nonailable Warrants have been issued as well as impugned order dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-7) vide which the proclamation has been issued against the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.23 dated 12.3.2022 u/s 380, 427, 457, 34 IPC 1860 (Corresponding sections 305, 324(4), 331(4), 3(5) BNS 2023), PS Sadar Phagwara, Distt. Kapurthala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner noted down a wrong date, he could not appear before the learned trial Court on the date fixed. As such, the learned trial Court cancelled his bail order and bail/surety bonds of the petitioner have been forfeited to the State vide order dated 09.03.2026 (Annexure P-6) and thereafter, proclamation was

issued against the petitioner vide order dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner further prays that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the Court and prays that the impugned orders be set aside.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Parneet Singh Pandher, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. I have heard the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the case file.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, this Court does not find any legitimate ground to interfere in the impugned orders dated 09.02.2026, 09.03.2026 and 23.03.2026 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Phagwara. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within next 07 working days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be considered and decided by the Court concerned within a period of three days.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
