1. A perusal of the order dated 01.12.2011 would show that the present writ petition was admitted for regular hearing.
2. As per office report, respondent No.3 could not be served for want of correct address. Learned counsel for the petitioner was intimated to furnish the correct address but has failed to do so.
3. An IOIN was filed by the Registry to list the main case for some actual date in motion hearing after informing the learned counsel for the parties.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of making best efforts, correct address of respondent No.3 could not be collected.



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5. A perusal of the order dated 29.11.2025 passed by this Court would show that during the pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner has expired and sought time to implead the LR's of petitioner.

6. At request of learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner, which has not been opposed by the learned State counsel, the main petition (CWP-10402-2011) is taken on board today itself.

7. Today learned counsel submits that in spite of his best efforts, legal representatives of the petitioner have not come forward to pursue the present writ petition and has prayed that the present petition be disposed of having rendered infructuous, however, liberty may be granted to the LR's of the petitioner to file an appropriate application for revival of the petition, if any cause still survives.

8. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous with liberty aforesaid.

9. IOIN also stands disposed of.

10. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
