DEEPINDER SINGH NALWA, J. (Oral)

1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners have challenged the action of the respondents whereby, the claim of the petitioners have not been considered for appointment on the posts of computer teachers in pursuance to the advertisement dated 27.04.2010 (Annexure P-1) issued by the respondents.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners have secured good marks and their names fall in the merit list, therefore, they are entitled to be considered for the abovesaid post.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submit that the present writ petition may be disposed of by treating the present writ petition as a representation and the same will be decided in accordance with law.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners does not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel for the respondents.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and consider and decide the same within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.
