1. Present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.152 dated 17.05.2001, registered under Sections 427, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender, however, this Court vide order dated 29.04.2026, quashed the order dated 24.08.2004, whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender, passed in CRM-M-23730-2026 as he had already joined the trial before the trial Court. He thus, submits that in view of the said fact, the present petition has become infructuous and the same be disposed of.
3. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
