YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (ORAL)

1. This appeal is directed against the Award dated 10.02.2003 passed in MACT Case No.6 of 2001 by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Patiala (for short 'Tribunal') in a petition under Section 166 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide which the above said claim petition has been dismissed.

2. As per report dated 25.08.2025 received from Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the parties have mutually settled the dispute. As per the settlement arrived at between the parties, respondent No.3-Insurance Company has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- as compensation to appellant, over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal, which has been agreed to be paid within 60 days.

3. In view of the aforesaid settlement arrived at between the parties, the parties are no more at issue either on a question of facts or law and accordingly, the appeal in hand is disposed of in terms of settlement dated 25.08.2025 and parties shall be bound by the same. No order as to costs.

4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
