KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner has filed the instant petition for quashing impugned award dated 06.09.2010 passed by Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Rohtak whereby, reference is answered against him.
2. It is to be noted that the petitioner, who has since died, is now represented by his legal representatives.
3. During the pendency of instant petition, the parties made an effort to settle the dispute through amicable means.
4. This Court is of the considered view that in case, respondent No. 2, pays a sum of Rs.1,00,000/-, as lumpsum compensation, dispute can be given quietus once and for all.

5. Both, the LRs of petitioner, and respondent No. 2, have agreed to the proposal made by this Court.

6. In the wake of the consensus arrived at between the parties, this Court is not required to delve into the merits of the instant matter. Consequently, respondent No. 2 is directed to remit an amount of Rs.1,00,000/-, in the account of LRs of the petitioner, within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order, failing which, he shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum, from the date of filing of this petition.

7. Accordingly, the impugned award stands modified to the extent indicated above, and the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.
