Mr.Amit Kumar son of Sumitra who has attained majority is present in person. He is identified by Mr.Sat Narain Yadav, Advocate and he has also filed his self attested copy of his adhaar card, The same is taken on record.

Discussed.

A statement made on behalf of the **appellants** that in full and final satisfaction of **their** claim, an amount of **Rs.6,50,000/- (Rupees Six Lacs Fifty Thousand only)** over and above the amount awarded by the tribunal be awarded and be disbursed to **appellants**, having been accepted on behalf of the insurer of the offending vehicle besides, statement having been made by Mr.Amit Kumar on instructions from his mother, Sumitra, appellant No.1 that the enhanced amount be paid to her and that she undertakes to satisfy claim of the other appellants in terms of the apportionment ordered by the learned Tribunal in case of any dispute arising inter se the appellants as regard apportionment, the appeal is disposed of with a direction to the insurer to deposit with the office of the Lok Adalat a cheque in the sum of **Rs.6,50,000/- (Rupees Six Lacs Fifty Thousand only)** favouring **appellant No.1-Sumitra, for and on behalf of all the claimants**, within six weeks from today, failing which the amount hereby awarded shall carry interest @ 9% per annum from the date of this order till payment thereof.

The cheque so deposited may be collected by the above-named **appellant** or the counsel representing the **appellants** against proper receipt.

Miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.

A copy of this order be made available to each of the appearing counsel, and file be consigned.
