SUBHAS MEHLA, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for transfer of investigation in FIR No.195 dated 04.12.2025 registered under Sections 21(C)/25 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka from local police to an independent agency such as Central Bureau of Investigation/Special Investigating Team (SIT) to ensure fair and impartial investigation.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the son of the petitioner is accused in the present FIR; he has been falsely involved in the present case at the behest of respondent Nos.5 to 7 as there was a previous enmity between the families of petitioner and respondent Nos.6 and 7; due to the said grudge, respondent No.6 by taking advantage of his official position has lodged the false FIR. As such, learned counsel prayed for transfer of investigation of the present FIR.



3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Anup Singh, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State and submitted that huge quantity of contraband has been recovered from the conscious possession of the son of the petitioner; at the time of effecting recovery, police officials of CIA Staff, Fazilka along with the officials of BSF were present and the present petition has been filed just to pressurize the authorities.
5. Heard.
6. Keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel, this Court finds no merit in the present petition and the same stands dismissed accordingly.
