VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. Counsel for the parties submitted that the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled through mediation. The compromise/settlement has been reduced into writing by the Mediator and the same has been signed by Saint Gurdev Singh—appellant and on behalf of the respondents by Jagtar Singh and Jagsir Singh.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has also produced on record a Resolution dated 02.03.2026 passed by the Gram Panchayat, Pathrala, whereby the present Panchayat has adopted the said compromise and resolved that it has no objection if the compromise arrived at between the parties is given effect to.

3. In view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the compromise. The compromise shall form part of the decree.
