Petitioner-Heena @ Vidyarthi Rao (transgender), aged 57 years, has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his other disciples/*Chelas* from the hands of respondents No.4 to 13, with further direction to respondent No.3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner at the behest of private respondents.

2. Petitioner is already facing FIR No.23 dated 22.01.2026 under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 351(2), 190 and 191(3) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, and anticipatory bail proceedings in the said FIR are already pending before this Court in petition (CRM-M-8207-2026), which is listed for 11.05.2026. Therefore, prayer made in the instant petition for grant of protection etc. seems to be completely misconceived.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to avail any other alternative remedy available to the petitioner under the law.
4. Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty sought and recorded hereabove.
