Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115 dated 31.03.2026, registered under Sections 18(c) and 27(a) of NDPS Act, at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

2. On 28.04.2026, the following order was passed by a Coordinate Bench:-

“Petitioner-Balram has filed this petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.115, dated 31.03.2026, under Sections 18(c) and 27(a) of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that he has not been named in the FIR; in fact, he has been named by the main accused, Surjeet @ Jeetu, in the disclosure statement recorded before the police. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

On advance notice, Mr. Abhishek Yadav, DAG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana.

Learned counsel representing State pointed out that the petitioner has also been named as an accused by the main accused, Surjeet @ Jeetu, who is behind bars. On a pointed query, he confirmed that the present petitioner is not involved in any other FIR. Let the status report be filed.

Adjourned to 02.07.2026, for filing status report.

In the meantime, arrest of petitioner is stayed subject to joining of his investigation.”

3. Today, learned State counsel has produced status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Nar Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bhuna, District Fatehabad, which is taken on record.

4. She, on instructions from ASI Tarsem, Police Station Sadar Fatehabad submits that pursuant to order dated 28.04.2026, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the fact that petitioner has duly joined investigation and keeping in view the statement given by learned counsel representing the State of Haryana, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 28.04.2026 is made absolute, subject to compliance of the provisions as envisaged under Section 482 (2)BNSS.
