1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the speaking order dated 05.06.2024 (Annexure P-23), issued by the respondents, whereby they have decided not to consider grant of weightage of 2/3/5 marks of higher education to the candidates against the instant selection process, despite giving specific undertaking before the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.1898 of 2023 that they will finalize this selection process in terms of advertisement dated 06.03.2020 (Annexure P-3) only. Further, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider both the petitioners for appointment as ETT teacher against EWS (General) category

in the instant selection, by granting them weightage of 2/3/5 marks of higher education.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since the petitioners have been selected in the other selection process, therefore, he wishes to withdraw the present petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
