1. Apprehending their arrest in Complaint No. 74774 dated 17.02.2026, pending before Additional Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana; for offences under Sections 318(1), 316, 111(1), 351(1) of BNS, 2023; the petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking pre-arrest bail.

2 Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Police Commissionerate Ludhiana. The same be kept on record. Paragraph No.3 of the said affidavit reads thus:
