1. Petitioner-Gursajan Bedi has filed instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 (corresponding Section 438 Cr.P.C.) (wrongly typed Section 439 Cr.P.C.) for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.228, dated 12.09.2025, under Sections 420 (Section 318 BNS), 120-B IPC (Section 61(2) BNS) registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.
2. The matter was being argued.
3. At this stage, learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, on instructions from Sub Inspector Baldev Singh, pointed out that in this case offence under Section 316 (2) and Section 217 BNS, 2023 have been added vide Rapat No.24, dated 29.09.2025.

4. At this stage, learned counsel representing the petitioner states that he intends to withdraw the present anticipatory bail petition with liberty to file fresh one with better and correct particulars and accordingly withdraws the same.

5. In view of the above statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, with aforesaid liberty.

6. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
