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1. The instant application under Rule 3-A (I) Chapter VI Part B, Vol.V of the High Court Rules and Orders has been filed for grant of leave to file the present petition.

2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

MAIN CASE

1. The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that, despite the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Malerkotla, having passed a speaking order dated 09.12.2025 (Annexure P-4) in compliance with the order dated 27.10.2025 passed by this Court in CWP No.31412 of



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2025, the nuisance of cattle sheds/dairies operating in residential areas continues to exist.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, for the said purpose, has filed a representation dated 30.03.2026 addressed to respondent No.6-The Executive Officer, Municipal Council, District Malerkotla, Punjab (Annexure P-5).

3. The Executive Officer, Municipal Council, District Malerkotla, Punjab, is directed to ensure compliance of the aforesaid order and to file a compliance report within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
