1. The petitioner has approached this Court challenging the impugned notices dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-11) and 31.08.2020 (Annexure P-16) issued u/s 13(4) of Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short SARFAESI Act), on various grounds.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail the remedy as an aggrieved person u/s 17 of the SARFAESI Act before the jurisdictional DRT.

3. In view of the request, the petitioner is granted 15 days' time to approach the DRT and till then, the status quo order passed by this Court on 09.09.2020, shall continue.

4. We make it clear that the Tribunal shall decide the request for interim relief strictly on merits of the matter while taking up the SA, and



shall not be influenced by the fact of this Court continued the status quo order. The Tribunal shall apply its own mind and is free to grant or refuse to grant the interim relief as the case may be.

5. Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
