JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No.2 to proceed with and dispose of its claim petition No.ED-2025-0003150 filed under section 18 of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 (for short 'MSMED Act') in a time bound manner.

2. The petitioner is an MSME engaged in the manufacturing of electrical equipment including high-tension switchgear panels. It delivered 2 panels to respondent No.4 and raised invoice dated 29.04.2023 of Rs.37,87,800/-. A sum of Rs.17,33,900/- is outstanding against the respondent No.4. It filed application before respondent No.2-Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Council on 28.11.2025 seeking redressal but the same has not been listed till date.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the competent authority would look into the matter and needful would be done.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.
5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of. Let the application of petitioner be considered expeditiously.
