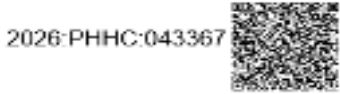

1. The present matter pertains to the year 2005 and has remained pending for an inordinately long period. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the appellants. It is further evident from the record that none has appeared on their behalf on the previous dates of hearing as well, namely 21.08.2024, 24.07.2025, and 18.12.2025. A perusal of the paper-book reveals that Mr. D.P.S. Bajwa, Advocate, who was earlier representing the appellants, had been duly informed; however, despite such intimation, no one has chosen to appear. In these circumstances, it can reasonably be inferred that the appellants are no longer interested in pursuing the present appeal. Keeping the matter pending indefinitely, in the absence of any representation or intent to prosecute the appeal, would serve no useful purpose and would only burden the docket unnecessarily.

2. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution.

3. As a natural corollary, since the main case stands disposed of, all pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them pending.
