1. Through the instant petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.299 dated 10.10.2023 registered under Sections 21(b), 20(b)(ii)B of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Industrial Area Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

2. Vide order dated 04.05.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

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3. Learned State counsel on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 11.05.2026 and his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. In view of the fact that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and given the nature of allegations, his pre-trial incarceration is not required. As such, without commenting on merits of case, it is observed that a case for release of petitioner on anticipatory bail is made out. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the order 04.05.2026 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

5. Since the main petition has been disposed of, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
