RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking issuance of directions to the official respondent Nos.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of private respondents and take action on her representation (Annexure P-10).

2. At the very outset, learned senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has made a representation (Annexure P-10) raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. She further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 4-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon, qua threat perception.

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3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Jasjit Singh Rattu, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 4-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-10) of the petitioner qua threat perception only within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
