1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the statutory pay scale to the petitioners as per Punjab Education Department Ministerial and Non-Teaching Staff (Headquarter) Group-C Service Rules, 2018 (Annexure P-5) i.e. Rs.10300-34800 + Grade Pay of Rs.3200/- from the date of entry into service along with arrears @ 12% per annum and to take into account the abovesaid statutory pay scale for future pay revisions and to grant the benefit of instructions dated 05.01.2026 (Annexure P-7) after calculating the pay scale as Rs.10300-34800 + 3200 G.P. Further, seeking issuance of a writ or certiorari for quashing the instructions dated 17.07.2020 & 29.10.2020 (Annexures P-3 & P-4).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for redressal of their grievances, the petitioners have also served legal notice dated 27.01.2026 (Annexure P-8) to the respondents which is still pending consideration. He further submits that at this stage, the



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petitioners would be satisfied, if appropriate directions are issued to the respondents to consider and decide the said legal notice, by passing a speaking order, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Swapan Shorey, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.
6. Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide legal notice dated 27.01.2026 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioners expeditiously, by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereon shall be conveyed to the petitioners.
