For the reasons mentioned in the applications, duly supported by an affidavit, CMs are allowed as prayed for.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

CM-3559 & 3435-C-2026

The present applications have been filed under Section 151 CPC for placing on record the compromise deed dated 05.03.2026 (Annexure A-1) arrived at between the parties.

For the reasons mentioned in the applications, duly supported by an affidavit, CMs are allowed as prayed for. Compromise deed dated 05.03.2026 is taken on record as Annexure A-1.

RSA-2485-2005

1. The case was taken up for hearing today itself.
2. The plaintiffs, parties to the compromise are present in Court. Pushwinder Singh and Davinder Singh, sons of Swaran Singh, who are present in Court, have admitted that they intend to withdraw the suit, as the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.
3. As per the settlement, the appellants agreed to pay a total sum of Rs. 1,03,00,000/- to the respondents. Out of this, Rs. 11,50,000/- had already been transferred through RTGS, and Rs. 1,50,000/- was paid in cash to Pushwinder Singh on 07.01.2026 as a token amount towards the settlement of the dispute. The balance amount of Rs. 90,00,000/- has been paid through demand drafts, the full details of which are recorded in the compromise deed annexed with the application.
4. Both Pushwinder Singh and Davinder Singh have acknowledged receipt of the entire sum of Rs. 1,03,00,000/- and have stated



that they have no objection to the disposal of the appeals in accordance with the terms of the compromise deed (Annexure A-1).

5. In view of the above, and in accordance with the compromise deed (Annexure A-1), the appeal is allowed, and the judgment and decree assailed in the present suit is set aside. The compromise deed (Annexure A-1) shall form an integral part of the decree and shall be enforceable as such.

6. This disposal ensures that the dispute between the parties is conclusively resolved in accordance with their mutually agreed settlement.

7. A photocopy of the order be placed on the file of other connected case.
