1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the regularization letters dated 06.03.2020, 25.02.2020 & 09.03.2020 (Annexure P-2) being illegal, arbitrary and unreasonable. Further, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners in terms of policy dated 04.03.1999 (Annexure P-1) w.e.f. the date of completion of their 10 years of services with all consequential benefits including full pay scale and arrears with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. The earlier writ petition filed by the petitioners bearing *CWP No.13790 of 2024 titled as 'Gurmail Kaur and others Vs. State of Punjab and others'* claiming the similar relief as claimed in the instant petition was withdrawn by them, vide order dated 31.05.2024, which reads as under :-

“1. The present petition has been filed for quashing the impugned regularization letters dated 06.03.2020 and



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- 04.06.2019 being illegal, arbitrary and unreasonable.*
2. *After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the instant petition to pursue the department.*
3. *Ordered accordingly.”*

2. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant petition.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
