Main case

1. The present petition is being filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), and all other enabling provisions of law, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction, directing the official respondents to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners, to carry out a fair, impartial, and expeditious investigation for tracing and recovering the missing son of the petitioners, namely Rahul, and to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents in accordance with law.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to look into the

representation dated 27.04.2026 (Annexure P-7), within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Sahil Chowdhary, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents-State.
5. Without advertng to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to look into the representation dated 27.04.2026 (Annexure P-7) expeditiously, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
6. The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
7. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
