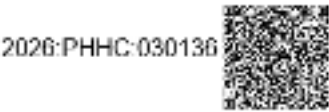

YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)

1. The present Regular Second Appeal is directed against the judgment and decree dated 03.11.2004 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Jagadhari, whereby the appeal preferred by the appellant/defendant was allowed and the judgment and decree dated 20.11.2002 passed by the Court of the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jagadhari, in Civil Suit No. 599 of 1992 titled *Shyamo*



and others vs. Shri Ashok Kumar and others, was set aside vide which the suit for declaration filed by the respondents/plaintiffs had been dismissed.

2. Report has been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, according to which the parties have settled their dispute as per the amicable settlement/agreement placed on record. The statements of the parties have also been recorded before the Mediator, wherein they have requested that the suit be disposed of on the basis of the compromise/settlement.

3. I am satisfied that the suit has been lawfully compromised and that no dispute now survives regarding any question of fact or law. Accordingly, the present appeal is disposed of and the suit filed by the plaintiffs is decreed in terms of the compromise/settlement arrived at between the parties, which shall form part of the decree sheet. The decree sheet be drawn accordingly. Parties shall bear their own costs.

4. Pending misc. application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
