Present appeal has been filed by the appellant, challenging the order dated 24.04.2026 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind, whereby anticipatory bail petition filed by the appellant, in case, FIR No.21 dated 23.02.2026, under sections 3(5), 351(3) of BNS (corresponding to sections 34, 506 of IPC) and section 3(1)(r) and 3(1)(s) of SC/ST Act, 1989, registered at PS Alewa, District Jind, was dismissed.
