The present appeal has been filed by the injured-claimant seeking enhancement of the compensation of Rs.1,20,000/- awarded by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Jagadhri (hereinafter 'the Tribunal'), vide Award dated 09.01.2008 passed in MACT case No.73 of 2005/06 dated 07.10.2005/12.08.2008 filed under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, (in short 'MV Act').

On the last date of hearing, none had appeared on behalf of the parties. As per office report, counsel representing the appellant had been duly informed through e-mail, yet none has put in appearance for the injured/claimant. Clearly, thereofre, neither the appellant nor the learned counsel for the appellant are serious in pursuing the present appeal.

This Court has perused the case file in minute detail. It is recorded in the Award passed by the Tribunal that '*the claimant has not suffered any disability due to the injuries suffered in this accident. So he is not entitled to any amount of compensation on account of future loss of income*'. As per record, appellant had only sustained a minor abdominal injury in the accident in question. Accordingly, no ground is made out for enhancement of compensation.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
