1. Mr. Harmanjot Singh Gill, learned counsel, entered appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 and has filed a memo of appearance. The same is taken on record. The Registry is directed to do the needful.

2. The challenge in the instant petition is to the action of the respondents whereby the petitioner's admission to the B.Sc. Nursing course was cancelled on the ground that the petitioner belongs to the deprived SC category, despite having applied under the SC category.

3. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the controversy involved in the instant petition is squarely covered by the decision of this Court in **CWP No.5545 of 2026**, decided on 26.02.2026.

4. Our attention has been invited to the fact that after the filing of the instant petition, the fee deposited by the petitioner was refunded.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances, it is directed that

the petitioner shall be at liberty to re-deposit the fee that has been refunded, and the same shall be accepted by respondent No.3. The petitioner shall be allowed to continue with the course.

6. In that view of the matter, the instant writ petition is also allowed in terms of **CWP No.5545 of 2026.**

7. All pending misc. application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
