1. On 15.09.2005, the following order passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have no cudgels in regard to the seniority list of the Constables prepared pursuant to the judgment rendered by this Court in Civil Writ Petition No.7317 of 2004 decided on September 25, 2004.

He further contends that the petitioners had already completed the Lower School Course on March 07, 2005 i.e. before the orders of withdrawal could be against the petitioners. He further contends that the petitioners have been duly granted Command Certificates in this regard. However, the petitioners are not being brought on list C-I despite having completed the Course accordingly. He further states that by bringing the petitioners on list C-1, the persons in the seniority list drawn accordingly would not be affected in any manner.

Notice of motion for January 20, 2005.”

2. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner No.2 passed away on 04.11.2023 and petitioner No.3 stands promoted.

3. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that with the efflux of time, petitioners have lost their interest to pursue the matter.
4. ***Dismissed*** with liberty to the petitioners to move an appropriate application within six months from today, if cause survives.
