1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for setting aside the seniority list dated 01.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) and supplementary seniority list dated 03.01.2019 (Annexure P-6), whereby the petitioner has been given seniority w.e.f. 15.01.2010 i.e. from the date of appointment, whereas similarly situated candidates have been given antedated seniority on the basis of their performance/marks in recruitment process as well as orders dated 20.12.2019 and 17.01.2020 (Annexures P-8 and P-9), whereby the claim of the petitioner for seniority and promotion has been rejected on erroneous grounds. Further, seeking for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to

grant seniority and all consequential benefits from the date it was given to candidate Jasvir Singh as well as respondents No.3 to 28 on the basis of performance/marks in recruitment process and further to promote the petitioner in PES cadre as Principal, and to grant him all consequential benefits.

2. As per office report, fresh notices could not be issued to the private respondents for want of correct addresses.
3. No one was present on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing i.e. 23.09.2025 and even today also, the position is the same. It appears that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present petition.
4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
