1 In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider their case for grant of family pension being children of the deceased-Sukhdev Singh (father).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the petitioners have attained majority and as such, being children of the deceased-Sukhdev Singh (father), they are entitled for family pension. He, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that the petitioners will be satisfied, if at this stage, a direction is given to respondents No.2 and 3 to re-consider their case for grant of family pension and to decide the same in a time bound manner.



3. Learned counsels appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State and respondent No.4 do not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners.

4. In view of above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to re-consider the case of the petitioners, for grant of family pension, and decide the same in accordance with law/rules, within a period of 02 months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are held entitled for grant of family pension, as per law/rules, the same be granted to them, within a period of 01 month, thereafter.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
