1 Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus, for directing the respondents to renew/reissue the passport to the petitioner.

2. At this stage, Mr. Arnav Kumar, Advocate appears on behalf of the respondents – UOI, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to him and informs the Court that as on date no application for renewal/re-issuance of passport of the petitioner is pending with the Passport Authorities, as the earlier application filed by the petitioner already stands closed. He further submits that, in case petitioner submits fresh application for renewal/re-issuance of passport supported by relevant information/documents, the same shall be considered by the Passport Authorities and an appropriate order (as the circumstances may warrant)

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would be passed thereon within a period of eight weeks from submission of aforesaid application by the petitioner, in accordance with law.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by the learned counsel for respondents, no further order is required to be passed and the present writ petition stands disposed of, accordingly.

4. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
