The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.119, dated 12.06.2025, under Section 109 of B.N.S/307 of IPC and 3(5) of B.N.S/34 of IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Beas, Amritsar Rural (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.05.2026, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation. However, learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the matter has been

resolved between the parties amicably and she has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 11.05.2026 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
