KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (ORAL)

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the legality of award dated 05.08.2019 (Annexure P-1), passed by respondent No.2, has been put to challenge by the petitioner/Management, wherethrough, the compensation of Rs.3,00,000/-, was awarded to respondent No.3/workman, to be paid within a period of one month, from the date of publication of the award, failing which, the respondent No.3/workman, would further be entitled for interest @ 9%, from the date of publication till realization.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to point out any illegality or perversity in the award (supra). She only confines her prayer with regard to the issue of interest, as awarded by



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3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.3/workman, submits that he is ready to forego his right of interest, as awarded by learned Tribunal, in case, this Court passes a direction upon the petitioner/Management, to pay the compensation, in a time bound manner.

4. In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties concerned, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**, with a direction upon the petitioner/Management, to pay the compensation of Rs.3,00,000/-, to respondent No.3/workman, within a period of nine weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. 5. Needless to say, in case, the above said amount is not deposited within the stipulated period, the respondent No.3/workman, would further be entitled for interest @ 9%, on the delayed payment.
