JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to pay compensation as per new policy issued by Government of Haryana vide notification dated 10.07.2024 *qua* land comprised in Killa Nos.5, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 situated in Village Binjhol, Tehsil & District Panipat upon which 11,000 voltage electrical line was laid in the year 1994-95.

2. As per petition, the petitioner along with his two sons are owners in cultivating possession of subjected land where respondent has laid 11,000 voltage electrical line. He was paid a meagre amount of ₹670/- at the time of erecting electric poles. He claims that he approached respondents on several occasions by way of filing representations but to no avail. He also served legal notices dated 19.03.2026 and 07.04.2026. Respondents replied to the same vide letter dated 01.04.2026 citing jurisdictional incompetence and asked him to approach Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited instead of Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited.

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3. Without commenting upon merits of the case, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to approach Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited for redressal of his grievance.
