1. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by order dated 15.07.2025 passed in ***CWP No. 19110 of 2014***, titled as “***Raj Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others***”.

2. Order dated 15.07.2025 passed in CWP No. 19110 of 2014 is reproduced as below:-

“1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 11.04.2013 (Annexure P-9) whereby their claim for grant of arrears on revision of pay scale from Rs.1200-2040 to Rs.4000-6000 w.e.f. 01.05.1990 has been rejected.

2. The petitioners claim that issue involved herein is no more res integra. A Division Bench of this Court vide judgment dated 25.03.2025 passed in a bunch



of petitions including Civil Writ Petition No.11710 of 2014 titled as 'Sarbars Singh and others Vs. The State of Haryana and others' has settled the issue.

3. *Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana expressed his inability to controvert applicability of above-said judgment to instant petition.*

4. *In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent to consider claim of petitioners in the light of afore-cited judgment.*

5. *Let the needful be done within a period of three months from today.”*

3. Learned State counsel expressed his inability to controvert applicability of aforesaid order to instant case.

4. In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of in terms of **Raj Kumar and others (Supra).**

5. Pending Misc. application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
