NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the promotion order dated 03.07.2016 (Annexure P-2), vide which, the Math Master are not being given proper consideration for promotion to the post of Lecturer (Political Science) in comparison to other subjects. Further, a writ in the nature of mandamus has been sought directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Lecturer (Political Science) w.e.f. 03.07.2016 by giving a proportionate share to Math Master in comparison to other subjects.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has already been

promoted to the post of Lecturer in Political Science, vide order dated 27.07.2017 w.e.f. 03.07.2016 and thereafter, he was retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.03.2024.

3. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
