1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the orders dated 30.12.2016 (Annexure P-2) and dated 04.05.2017 (Annexure P-8), whereby the pay of the petitioner was refixed from Rs.3220/- to Rs.3120/- with effect from 06.05.1996.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the petitioner has expired. Accordingly, the legal representatives of the petitioner were impleaded as parties to the present writ petition. Subsequently, during the pendency of the present writ petition, legal representative-Preet Pal Singh has also expired. Learned counsel further submits that despite making various efforts to contact the legal representatives of Preet Pal Singh, he could not contact them. Taking into consideration the abovesaid facts, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the present writ

petition may be disposed of with the liberty to file an application for revival of the writ petition, if any cause survives.

3. In view of the abovesaid submissions, the present writ petition is disposed of with the liberty, as prayed for.
