





surrender herself before learned trial Court and prayed that the petitioner be not arrested by the police.

3. Considering the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, no notice is required to be issued to the respondent.

4. Heard, and paper book perused.

5. Keeping in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to appear/ surrender herself before the learned trial Court within a period of two weeks and to move an appropriate application regarding compounding of offence, if she desires so, as well as bail application, by raising all the pleas taken in this petition, before the trial Court regarding her non-appearance. The concerned Court is directed to decide her application in accordance with law. Till then, the petitioner will not be arrested by the police in this matter. It is made clear that if the petitioner fails to appear before the Court concerned within the stipulated time period, then the relief granted by this Court shall deemed to be withdrawn.

6. Petition is accordingly disposed of.
