1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the transfer order dated 22.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) vide which, the petitioner was transferred from Police Lines to Police Station Garhshankar.

2. A perusal of the facts of the case would show that this Court, vide order dated 26.07.2022, stayed the operation of the impugned transfer order. In terms of the above said interim order, the petitioner has continued to work at Police Lines. Taking into consideration the facts that more than 3½ years have elapsed and the petitioner is working at Police Lines, learned counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that that the present petition may be disposed of. He further submits that in case, the petitioner is transferred by the respondents, the relevant Rule/Policy in respect of transfer

should be taken into consideration.

3. Learned State counsel does not oppose to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In light of the statement given by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case, the respondents decide to transfer the petitioner, the relevant Policy/Rules in regard to transfer be taken into consideration.
