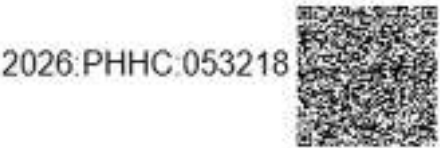

MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to register an FIR against the private respondents and also to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

2. At the very outset, learned State counsel, in terms of the reply, has submitted that a detailed inquiry was conducted on the representations moved by the petitioners, whereby it was found that the dispute was of civil nature and even civil litigation was pending between the parties. Hence, the same were filed as no police action was required. Even during inquiry, no threat was found to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners could not dispute the aforesaid facts.



4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as no further orders are called for. However, the petitioners are granted liberty to avail their alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
