Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for quashing the letter dated 22.09.2017 (Annexure P-21) issued by respondent No.6 and further prayer for directing the respondents to fix the pension of petitioner @ Rs.28,130/- per month in terms of last pay drawn at the time of his retirement.

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 6, at the very outset, submits that gratuity of the petitioner has been released and in case, there is any pending dues against the gratuity, then the same will be released to the petitioner within a period of six weeks.

3. In view of above statement made by learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 6, present writ petition stands disposed of and respondent



No.4 is directed to release pending dues, if any, against the gratuity to the petitioner within a period of six weeks. Copy of the order be sent to the said respondent for necessary compliance.
